Support worker travel to an individual service

Alzheimer's WA endeavour to roster our support workers within 20kms of services. Where we do not have a support worker within 20kms of the service, additional costs of \$1.00 per km travelled above the 20km limit will be included in the individual agreement.

Cancellations

Where less than 24 hours' notice is received to cancel a service the service will be charged. When more than 24 hours' notice is provided there will be no charge applicable.

Outings during an individual service

If a support worker is required to use their own vehicle during an individual support service, a cost of \$1.00 per km travelled will be incurred. Standard km's are up to 10km per visit. As part of the individual agreement, a client may increase the number of kilometres to be travelled within a service at an additional cost of \$1 per km.

Participant Contributions

From 1st September 2026 participants will pay contributions based on an assessment of their income and assets. Contributions will differ for:

- clinical supports - no contribution
- independence services - moderate contributions
- everyday living services - highest contributions
